


- L & U offer services in the schools, community centers and churches in North Carolina and Virginia, which allows students to be tutored at a time and location that is convenient for parents.



Learning and You provides basic, remedial and enrichment services to students in grades K-12. Our tutoring instructional program uses a variety of research-based approaches and instructional methodologies that are prescriptive, skilled-based, thematic, and aligned with the common core standards.

The instructional focus is derived from the differentiated curriculum model. Students are pretested using a standardized test to identify their academic strengths and challenges. Once the skill levels of students have been identified, an individualized learning plan and the instructional tools are developed. Starting Fall 2012, the ACT will be aligned with the Common Core Standards and used to measure college and career readiness.

The teacher to student ratio is 1:5. Instruction is student-centered; the tutor creates instructional centers or stations with various activities that address an array of higher order thinking skills. Students rotate among the centers every 10-20 minutes.
